Central Bank Governor Participated in the Online Congress Organized in Nursultan

On December 14, Governor of the Central Bank Martin Galstyan participated in the Second International Congress “G-Global: World of the 21st Century” organized in online mode.

The Congress, arranged on the occasion of the 30th anniversary of Kazakhstan's independence, discussed issues related to the creation of “smart cities”, future developments in the financial sector, digital innovations and development of financial ecosystems, as well as regional issues.

Governor of the Central Bank of Armenia delivered a speech within the framework of the plenary session “Global Macroeconomic Policy Environment in the Context of the Ongoing Coronavirus Pandemic”, in which he, inter alia, referred to the inequality in the speed of economic recovery between developing and developed countries, the growth of domestic debt amid the pandemic, formation of global inflation and inflationary expectations.

The Congress was attended by representatives of the heads of central/national banks and a number of heads of international financial institutions.
